About the day

Therapeutic Assessment is a brief intervention for young people presenting with self-harm in emergency. It consists of identifying the vicious cycle of self-harm in the form of a diagram, followed by a collaborative development of an "exit", a way of breaking the cycle and moving forward. TA is linked with improved engagement compared with usual assessment.

Learning Outcomes

- Create a TA diagram depicting the vicious cycle of self-harm
- Develop an "exit" from the cycle
- Critically evaluate the evidence base of TA

Consultants, clinical leads, speciality doctors, nurse practitioners, educational psychologists, senior researchers, and those that work with children and young people affected with mental health issues.
